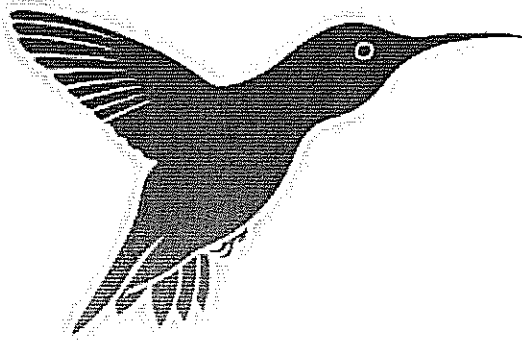

REQUIREMENTS FOR CREDITORS LIST

Each creditor to be listed on a petition must include the following:

1. Full name of Creditor
2. Complete address including zip code
3. Account Number
4. Amount owed
5. Name & address of collection agency or attorney handling account
6. If a creditor holds a security interest in an asset of the Debtor, the asset Needs to be fully described and also state its market value.

Example: Anytime Bank USA has a lien on a
1988 Ford Pick-Up Truck valued at
Approximately \$4,500.00.

7. If a debt has a co-signer(s), the co-signer(s) name and address will need to be listed by that particular creditor.
8. If wages are due and owing to employees, you must provide the name and address of the employee and the amount of wages owed.
9. A complete list including the name and address of all utility companies and taxes owed will be required and their status (current or past due).

REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHEDULE B PERSONAL PROPERTY

All items listed on Schedule B Personal Property are to be fully described. When showing items such as inventory, equipment, machinery, etc., these items must be listed separately with its own market value.
